

THECB Legislative Agenda: Outcomes-Based Formula Funding

Hispanics are earning degrees at **much higher levels** since 2000...

...but too many continue to fall **through the cracks** at too high a cost.



76% of those who enrolled in higher education did not graduate.

Community and Technical Colleges
Hispanic non-completers with debt: 14%
Average student debt total: \$5,800

Universities
Hispanic non-completers with debt: 52%
Average student debt total: \$9,100

1. Non-Completers with Debt is percentage of total Hispanic students who received a state or federal loan, were enrolled in 12 or more SCH at a Texas institution beginning in fall 2003, and did not graduate and were no longer enrolled in any state institution in fall 2009.

2. Average Student Loan Debt of Non-Completers includes total of all loans by source (state/federal) divided by total number of Hispanic students who received a loan, enrolled in 12 or more SCH at a Texas institution beginning in fall 2003, and did not graduate and were no longer enrolled in any state institution in fall 2009.
