RE: FY2017 Final Allocation for Texas Educational Opportunity Grant (TEOG)

On April 29, 2016 we issued preliminary allocation figures for the TEOG program. We invited institutions to confirm that the preliminary allocation spreadsheet accurately reflected the data submitted to the Coordinating Board. Institutions were allowed 10 days to review the data. That period ended at close of business on Friday, May 13, 2016.

Through this process the Coordinating Board received no comments about the data and calculations. We are announcing the enclosed amounts as the FINAL allocations for Fiscal Year 2017.

Institutions participating in the TEOG program will have the opportunity to submit their fund request form as early as August 1 and we will begin processing these requests the first day of the new fiscal year, September 1. On February 20, 2017, all unused TEOG funds will be reallocated and additional funds can be requested through the reallocation process.
