RE: FY2017 Final Allocation for Tuition Equalization Grant (TEG)

On May 23, 2016, updated preliminary allocation figures for the TEG program were issued. Institutions were invited to confirm that the updated preliminary allocation spreadsheet accurately reflected the data submitted to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB). Institutions were allowed 10 days to review the data. That period ended at the close of business on June 6, 2016.

Through this process, THECB received no comments about the data and calculations. We are announcing the enclosed amounts as the FINAL allocations for Fiscal Year 2017.

Institutions participating in the TEG program will have the opportunity to submit their fund request form as early as August 1, 2016 and we will begin processing these requests the first day of the new fiscal year: September 1, 2016. On February 20, 2017, all unused TEG funds will be reallocated and additional funds can be requested through the reallocation process.
