RE: FY2017 Final Allocation for B-On-Time (BOT) Loan Program

On June 10, 2016, preliminary allocation figures for BOT Loan program were issued. Institutions were invited to confirm that the preliminary allocation spreadsheet accurately reflected the data submitted to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB). Institutions were allowed 10 days to review the data. That period ended at the close of business on June 24, 2016.

During this process, THECB received comments about the data and calculations. Adjustments to the allocation calculations have been made to reflect those comments. We are announcing the enclosed amounts as the FINAL allocations for Fiscal Year 2017.
