RE: FY2017 Final Allocation for Toward EXcellence, Access, and Success (TEXAS) Grant Program

On June 10, 2016, preliminary allocation figures for the TEXAS Grant program were issued. Institutions were invited to confirm that the preliminary allocation spreadsheet accurately reflected the data submitted to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB). Institutions were allowed 10 days to review the data. That period ended at the close of business on June 24, 2016.

Through this process, THECB received no comments about the data and calculations. We are announcing the enclosed amounts as the FINAL allocations for Fiscal Year 2017.

Community Colleges, State Colleges, and Technical Colleges will be funded based on unused TEXAS Grant funds for those students who meet the eligibility criteria for a renewal award.

Institutions participating in the TEXAS Grant program will have the opportunity to submit their fund request form as early as August 1, 2016 and we will begin processing these requests the first day of the new fiscal year: September 1, 2016. On February 20, 2017, all unused TEXAS Grant funds will be reallocated and additional funds can be requested through the reallocation process.
