RE: 2017-18 B-On-Time (BOT) Loan Program Final Allocation Amount

This memo is to announce the enclosed final allocation amount for the BOT loan program for the 2017-18 academic year.

On May 5, 2017, preliminary allocation figures for the BOT loan program were issued electronically to institutions. Institutions were invited to confirm that the preliminary allocation spreadsheet accurately reflected the data submitted to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB). Institutions were allowed 10 days to review the data. That period ended at the close of business on May 19, 2017. Through this process, THECB received comments about the data and adjustments to the allocation calculations have been made to reflect those comments.

Institutions participating in the BOT loan program can begin certifying loans for eligible BOT recipients. Disbursement dates for BOT loans must be set **after September 6, 2017**. Any BOT certifications already submitted through the Higher Education Loan Management System (HELMS) will be adjusted by the Coordinating Board staff if the disbursement date was made before September 6.

As a reminder, the maximum award amount for BOT for the 2017-18 year is **\$9,050** (\$4,525 per semester). Private and Independent institutions have until **November 20, 2017** to encumber BOT program funds that have been allocated by certifying all eligible loan applications. On **February 20, 2018**, both private and public institutions lose claim to any unspent funds not yet disbursed to students. All unencumbered funds may be reallocated to institutions requesting these funds.
